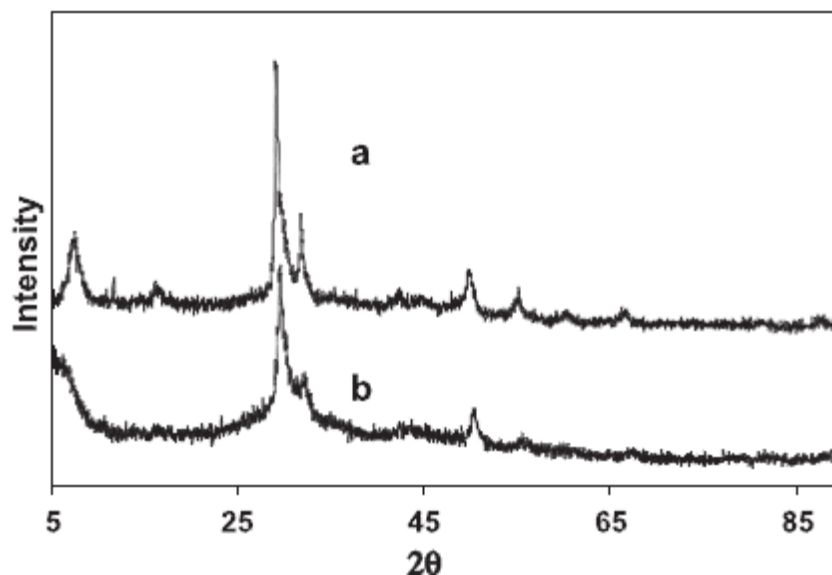


Figure 1. The initial results of the proposed wireless system
